



Tyler Arboretum Master Plan

Viridian worked with Cahill Associates, SMP Architects and ecologist Roger Latham to develop a new master plan for Tyler Arboretum, one of the largest privately held tracts of open space in Delaware County. Viridian is guiding the arboretum as they craft a new vision that will reaffirm their status as a must-see destination within the horticulturally rich region.

Strategic objectives are being developed through meetings with the Arboretum board and staff. The team and client are developing options for integrating new exhibits and programs into the site including watershed initiatives and natural area strategies for ecological restoration. Concepts concerning circulation, plant collections, regional connections, building assessment and future building options are being explored.
